

# HALF-YEAR REPORT 2025

Periode January - June



Firstly, we would like to give a big thanks to Awas kaki for their support so that we can carry out projects in Indonesia. The projects we are currently doing are **Project Study funds**, **Soccer Projects**, **and Sumba Project 2025**. Our first project this year began with the Soccer Project in January with Coach Ronald, Coach Jan Melchers, coach Peter and me. Together, we visited several locations across Java, where we had the opportunity to engage with local clubs and communities. These visits left a strong and positive impression, not only on the clubs but also on the students and coaches we met along the way. Hundreds of children and dozens of local coaches have been coached through the sessions. We leave with a good impressions in our pocket!



This year, we have also taken an important step in developing future leaders in football by sponsoring two young coaches to attend the official basic coaching license course organized by the Indonesian Football Association in May. Coach Raihan is a gifted young coach with strong potential, already showing great promise in his local community. Meanwhile, Coach Febrian will benefit this opportunity as a foundational step to launch Project Sumba 2025, where his skills and knowledge will directly contribute to develop young talents in Sumba.



# **GREAT NEWS FROM COACH APRIANKE!**

We're excited to share some wonderful news from Coach Anke, who has been part of our Project Ternate in Maluku. He has recently become a teacher at a vocational high school in his hometown. What makes this even more special is that the school has interest in opening a soccer school and Coach Anke has been appointed to lead it. Now we are discussing a lot about how to set the soccer school. We had weekly contact to talk about this! It's truly inspiring to witness his journey of transformation. We first met Anke in 2019 during a coaching clinic we conducted at his school. Seeing him grow from a participant into a leader who now shapes the next generation is a powerful reminder of the long-term impact of our programs.

# **PROJECT BANDUNGAN**

While we celebrate Coach Anke's inspiring progress, we also need to share a more sobering update regarding Project Bandungan. Despite our efforts, this project has not shown the meaningful development we had hoped for neither for the coach involved nor for the students participating. After careful consideration and evaluation, we have made the difficult decision to discontinue the project.

# **SUMBA PROJECT 2025**



Lastly, we're thrilled to share an exciting development from the Sumba Project 2025 through our initiative, Pelita Nusantara Soccer Club. This August, Febrian has been invited to meet with the Bupati (Regent) of East Sumba to present the vision and plan for Pelita Nusantara. He will also be joined by the Head of the East Sumba Football Association,

marking an important step in building strong local collaboration and official support for the project. A final note, we would also like to share a personal update regarding Febrian who will be traveling alone to Sumba. Due to health considerations related to his wife's pregnancy specifically a mioma condition that requires proper rest, medication, and access to suitable medical facilities, she will remain in Semarang for the time being. Febrian plans to return to Semarang before the expected due date, which is around mid-December, to be with his wife for the birth.



# STUDY FUND PROJECT

First, Study funds have been running very well. Last year, Awas kaki sponsored five children. They are Daniel and David, Nayla, Franz Rizky (Kiky), and Febrian Setiaji. Daniel is in Terang Bangsa school and he is now on the 8th grade. He is under Peter's team to compete with good tournament this July in Central Java. His brother, **David** is at 5th grade of elementary school. Nayla, one of our sponsored students, is now in her final year of high school. This year, she is focusing on completing her studies while also representing her school in regional and national basketball competitions. Franz Rizky (Kiky), he is awaiting his graduation this year and currently serves as a teacher and soccer coach at Terang Bangsa High School. Febrian had finished his study in Communication Science. He will graduated between July 29th July - August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Indeed, With both Franz Kiky and Febrian graduating this year, we have new sponsored student, **Tegar**. He will officially start school this half July together with other students.
